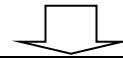

## Prom

Any student whose behaviour or attendance is unsatisfactory will be considered ineligible to attend. Students MUST meet a minimum of 85% attendance up to and including the time two weeks prior to the selected event date to be considered eligible.

School fundraising projects are an important part of All SMRH events. Therefore, participation in these opportunities is not only encouraged but Expected. Radio Bingo and Fishcake sales are the two main opportunities to become involved in school fundraising.

## Graduation

Prom is not Grad and vice versa.

Students in the Academic Program Do Not Know if they have Graduated High School until the Third Week Of July.

There are 2 opportunities for students who have not passed their Public Exams to rewrite in the August & November Supplementary Exams. For this reason, Graduation cannot occur until after the Second Week Of December at the Earliest.

Students who have not graduated cannot attend Graduation as a participant of the event.

Graduation Fees and responsibilities:

Gown Rentals are confirmed by Thanksgiving or thereabouts.

Graduation Fee: \$40.00 this covers keepsake mortar board cap, gown and vee stole rental, shipping & handling & associated printing and binding costs of programs and diplomas. In the last three consecutive years, nearly \$6000.00 in scholarships and endowments were awarded during the SMRH Graduation! Please remember that although Sr. Prom is a delightful party, their Grad really is the main cause for celebration

All Graduation fees are due PRIOR to the end of May 2016.
